The Sheep Show will be open to 4-H and FFA members in good standing currently enrolled in the Sheep Project or Exploring statewide.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. Ownership Rules that apply at the State Fair will apply at this show. Breeding animals must be owned by July 1, 2008.
2. Health papers in the exhibitor's name are required. Health regulations will be strictly enforced. See page 23.
3. Each exhibitor will be limited to two entries in the individual classes and one entry in the pen classes.
4. Rams exhibited must be purebred.
5. Animals must be on all four feet at all times.
6. No slapping.
7. Exhibitors must accompany their animals to the show, care for them and exhibit them, unless given prior approval.
8. Exhibitors with more than one animal in class may be assisted by another youth member, no parents.
9. Points for premium money will be as follows:
Blue - \$6.00, Red - \$4.00, White - \$2.00
10. A \$3.00 stall fee for each animal will be collected
11. Breed classes will be added as needed.
12. Ewe lambs can show in Market Lamb Class, but each animal can only show in one individual class.
13. Exhibitors may not leave or load until show conclusion.
14. Showmanship & Herdsman classes are open to all exhibitors.
15. The Superintendent or Judge may excuse any exhibitor at any time if abuse or poor sportsmanship is shown.

Exhibitors will be responsible for cleaning stalls or tie outs at conclusion of each show. Failure to do so will result in forfeited premium money. Breeds will show in alphabetical order, with crossbred last.
